In regards to the Proposed Rulemaking raising the rates to register copyrighted materials:

I am against making the registration process more expensive especially in light of the Copyright Office and the Library of Congress Mission " To promote the progress of science and useful arts, by securing for limited times to authors and inventors the exclusive right to their respective writings and discoveries" (U.S. Constitution, Article 1, Section 8)

This does not promote that mission it only makes it more burdensome and difficult to afford for any one trying to register copyrighted material.
