

I, C. Winston Taylor, am a member in good standing in the Society of Illustrators of Los Angeles, and have served as the past President and Vice-president and Show Chairman of this national organization. I have also been a member of the Graphic Artists' Guild of Los Angeles in the past.

After serving in Vietnam, I have worked as a freelance illustrator since graduation with the degree Awarded with Honors, a Bachelor of Fine Arts from Art Center College of Design, February 1973. I served as the President of Art Center Alumni. Since then I have illustrated many movie posters and advertisements. I published The Catalog of Illustrators which had an ISBN# in the United State Library System during the 1970's and 80's. To educate new artists, I included a copy of the copyright law to warn them of the down side of the "work for hire" clause among other questionable laws.

I ask you to change the law in favor of the small business owner instead of the big national corporations and multi-national organizations.
