Dear Mr. Perry:

The Copyright Office Board of Appeals [now, Review Board] has reviewed your second request for reconsideration of an Examining Division refusal to register five designs of "spinner blades," identified above, which serve as ornamentation for the wheels of automobiles. After reviewing your request for reconsideration, the Board has determined that the wheel spinners represent arrangements of elements, in sculptural forms, which satisfy the creativity requirement of Feist Publications, Inc. v. Rural Telephone Service Company, Inc., 499 U.S. 340 (1991). As a result, a decision has been made that the five works should be registered.

The file concerning these works will be returned to the Examining Division for processing, and the certificates of registration will be issued shortly.
