Pursuant to 17 U.S.C. 115(d)(4)(D)(i)(IV), the Mechanical Licensing Collective (“The MLC”) hereby files with the Copyright Office this notice of intent to conduct an audit (“Notice of Intent to Audit”) of Pacemaker Music AB.

Pursuant to 17 U.S.C. 115(d)(4)(D) and applicable regulations, The MLC intends to audit Pacemaker Music AB to verify the accuracy of all royalty payments to The MLC, including payments in connection with any related adjustments, arising from all covered activity occurring under the blanket license during the verification period beginning on January 1, 2021 and ending on December 31, 2023.
