Based on the amount of gross receipts reported (\$525,320.34) in Space K of the Statement of Account an incorrect form has been used. The SA-3 form completed is for cable systems with gross receipts more than \$527,600. The correct form appears to be the SA-1-2. Please complete and return the correct form, which can be obtained at www.copyright.gov/licensing.

Due to filing the wrong form, there appears to be a \$3,160.85 overpayment of the royalty fee. The correct royalty fee is \$3,934.20 but the amount submitted was \$7,095.05.
