Grady-White's patented fold down aft seat is located on the aft cockpit wall. (Patent#6.647.916 B2) On the horizontal top of the cockpit wall is a 291 quart insulated fishbox. A transom door is located in the starboard aft corner of the cockpit. There is a VacuFlush head and a stand-up shower located in the console above, with rod storage, tackle storage, microwave, sink and accommodations. The console features a raiseable radio box operating on an electric ram and the console supports the T-top enclosure. The anchor windlass is mounted below deck and the anchor and rode are paid out through an anchor chute in the hull bow.
